

## **Appendix 2 Schedule**

### **to the Terms and Conditions of the "Residency - We Share Space" Competition**

1. The "Residency - We Share Space" project will begin with a workshop meeting of all the Competition Winners with theatre pedagogues and representatives of the schools that applied for their participation in the "Residency - We Share Space" project.
2. Theatre pedagogues' task will be to support artistic and social projects in schools by: [1] consultation given to the Winners and [2] carrying out educational activities involving students in the art project and [3] personal participation in the performance of the project.
3. The residency activities under the Competition will be implemented between October 2022 and the end of the first quarter of 2023, with the results of the workshop meetings to be presented by 31 January 2023.
4. The residency includes at least four (4) workshop meetings with the active participation of students from a school or an educational facility. The result produced during the workshop meetings should be presented or staged in school or in front of an audience consisting of the local community in any form - determined by the Winner in cooperation with the students and the theatre pedagogues.
5. At the end of the "Residency - We Share Space" project, the Theatre plans to hold an evaluation meeting to summarise the project. The meeting will take place at the Theatre 21 / Centre of Inclusive Art.
6. In 2023, Theatre 21 envisages a presentation of the results of the "Residency - We Share Space" project at the Theatre 21 / Centre of Inclusive Arts, to which it will invite the Winners of the Competition to participate.
7. Participation of the Winners is obligatory in at least 4 workshop meetings, in the meeting presenting the effect of these workshops and in the evaluation meeting of the "Residency - We share the space" project.
8. The Winner's failure to comply with this Schedule or to complete the artistic and social project later than the Competition Period - in accordance with the Competition Terms and Conditions - may be grounds for the Winner not being awarded the Prize.
